He then completed an aesthetic and reconstructive breast/body fellowship at the teaching hospital of Harvard Medical School, Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts. During this time, Dr. Wright served as a plastic surgery clinical instructor at Harvard Medical School. Following his plastic and reconstructive surgery training, Dr. Wright returned to central Arkansas where he was an Assistant Professor of Surgery at UAMS before transitioning to private practice.
